The State Family Program Office is pleased to announce the 2014 Indiana National Guard Youth Camp will be held 6 - 12 July 2014 at Camp Atterbury. The theme for this year's camp is "Hoosier Heroes" and campers are encouraged to bring HERO themed items to wear throughout the week.

The Indiana National Guard Youth Camp is open to boys and girls ages 9-17. All camp attendees must have one parent in either the Indiana Air or Army National Guard to include National Guard youth of fallen service members. The Youth Camp will incorporate everyone's favorite activities including; archery, swimming, rappel and self defense. Kids AT is an overnight (6 nights) camp where campers stay in barracks supervised by adults.

Camp will be \$100.00 this year. Refunds will only be given, if you give notice by June 1, 2014. Please make personal checks payable to "Indiana National Guard Youth Camp."

Registering for camp does NOT ensure attendance. After registration closes, we will prioritize attendance for families of the fallen, youth recently experiencing a deployment, and dependents of current NG Service Members. If your camper is not chosen to attend, your full payment will be reimbursed.

YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE UNTIL ALL FORMS AND PAYMENT(S) ARE RECEIVED. CAMP CONFIRMATIONS WILL BE EMAILED OUT ON JUNE 1ST, 2014 and will include pertinent packing information and updates so please provide your most frequented email address.
